Amongst the number of things students must do as they prep for the big event (training, study, etc.) we realize that knowing where to stay and how to get where you need to go can be a big factors to consider.

### **On-Campus Options**

The 2022 Nationals will be held at the University of British Columbia, located at the very west end of Vancouver, right next to the water. That being said, the campus and the area itself is sizeable, so to be specific the base of operations within UBC will be the:
